



#### **RAINBOW WATERFALL**

This waterfall got its name from the spectacular rainbow that appears at its base around 9am every morning as the sun's rays hit the water. Tours to the falls begin at 6am, starting with an hour-long drive through the jungle and a 45-minute hike. Past the slippery streams and rocks, you may see more than one misty rainbow before it disappears.



#### **TIN MINES**

Take an eerie stroll through the once bustling tin mines that earned Sungai Lembing its former 'El Dorado of the East' nickname. With interconnected tunnels almost 700 meters deep and 320 kilometres long, the mine was once hailed the second richest tin deposit in the world and till today remains an iconic relic of Pahang's former economic domincance.



### **CLIMB PANORAMA HILL**

A beautiful hill that stands 291 meters above sea level, Panorama Hill is the spot to go for a dazzling view of the sunrise and the surrounding greenery in the early morning. It takes about 45 minutes to climb the concrete steps and the mountain trail leading to the top.



#### SUSPENSION BRIDGE

South of Sungai Lembing is the hundred-year-old suspension bridge near Kolong Pahat village. It's anything but a steady walk from start to finish, but still an ideal spot from which to photograph the river and the old town.

# **COCONUT BISCUITS** •

A roasted coconut wafer that leaves visitors stocking up on more, this beloved coconut biscuit snack is found in most markets and bakeries around Sungai Lembing town.



# MEE JAWA •

This dish combines blanched noodles in a light tomato broth with sweet potato, tofu, boiled eggs, prawns, vegetables and a touch of lime juice for tang. **The food court** at the entrance to Sungai Lembing town is said to serve excellent Mee Jawa.



### **TOFU AND TOFU FA**

Sungai Lembing's San Sui tofu (mountain water tofu) and tofu fa boast a rich taste and a silky smooth texture that's unique to the food in this town. Tofu is sliced into bricks that are charred at the base and dunked in a thick sauce topped with minced pork.



# **LEMBING NOODLES**

Lembing Noodles never fails to make it into the list of top 'must eats' at Sungai Lembing. Handmade from flour and water, these noodles are charcoal cooked till soft and served either dry or in a curried broth.





# Luscious Laksa

Explore the delectable line-up of laksa noodles across the states



"People who love to ent nre always the best people."

Any day of the week, rain or shine, locals and tourists will be flocking to roadside stalls and food courts in search of the delicious noodle broth dish known as laksa. Experts agree that there are two types of laksa: curry and assam. Curry laksa is made up of a broth base of coconut milk and spices, while assam laksa sports a sour, tamarind fish-soup base. Both are served with generous helpings of tofu, bean sprouts, seafood, chilies, slices of boiled egg, vegetables, and other goodies. The laksa noodles can be thick, white rice noodles, yellow wheat noodles, or the thinner, vermicelli noodles. The various laksa types are extremely popular in countries like Thailand and Singapore and also in other parts of the world as well. Which is the best one? You decide.

#### **JOHOR LAKSA**

A unique feature of Johor laksa is its use of spaghetti noodles instead of conventional white rice noodles, served in a spicy, milky broth made of coconut milk, fried spices, minced fish, garnished with Thai basil, mint leaves, daun kesum (polygonum or Vietnamese coriander), cucumber, bean sprouts and occasionally fresh cockles. The Lee Kee Johore Laksa stall first opened in 1946 and uses a tested laksa recipe that's been handed down from as early as post-World War 2 Johor Bahru.

# NYONYA LAKSA - MELAKA

Nyonya Laksa–sometimes called 'Laksa Lemak' is ideal for spice and chili lovers. A brilliant fushion of the flavour of yellow noodles soaked in an amazing broth of chicken bones and prawn shells, mixed with shrimp paste, ginger, onions, garlic, spices, and of course, coconut milk.

Most interesting laksa story?
Back home in Seremban, my parents would take me to our favorite curry mee stall. The same hawker sold Hainanese chicken.
Later on, I found that the soup begins with a good homemade chicken broth. Our curry mee hawker must have used the chicken carcasses from one day's Hainanese chicken to make the laksa soup for the next day!

What's the easiest laksa for first time tasters and the most complex one for die-hards? Easiest laksa? Laksa Lemak. The most complex: Definitely Assam Laksa. My least favorite laksa as a child but I began to enjoy this as I grew to love sour tastes and pungent broth.

What's the perfect drink to accompany your perfect laksa? My favorite drink to go with a good spicy laksa is a *Barli Limau Kosong!* Thinking about it really makes me miss home.

If you were to take a road trip around Malaysia specifically to eat laksa, where would your first port of call be, and why? Without a doubt, hands down: Penang for both Assam Laksa and Curry Mee! Throw in a baby oyster omelette and I'm in absolute foodie heaven!

#### SARAWAK LAKSA

Gaining worldwide appeal thanks to celebrity fans, stalls in Kuching serve this rice vermicelli dish in a spicy broth made from a paste of blended onions, garlic, ginger, lemongrass, spices and chilies, combined with coconut milk, roasted nuts, shredded omelet and prawns. The Choon Hui Café – which bears celebrity chef Anthony Bourdain's stamp of approval – opens at 7am to serve delicious Sarawak laksa.

### **PAHANG LAKSA**

This lesser-known laksa dish makes much use of coconut milk for its gravy base. It is made of thick white noodles in a minced fish broth flavoured with tamarind, ginger, onions, garlic and various ground spices, topped with crunchy raw vegetables. Join the hungry queues at the Sajian Pekan stall for a taste you won't forget.

### **ASSAM LAKSA - PENANG**

This one's a Baba-Nyonya influenced combo of shredded kembong fish (mackerel), tamarind, lemongrass, shrimp paste, and juicy white rice noodles, topped off with mint leaves, onions, chilies and shredded pineapple. Grab a small and completely satisfying bowl at the popular Pasar Air Itam Laksa stall close by to the Kek Lok Si Temple.

### **LAKSAM - KELANTAN**

This white-broth dish is hard to come by outside of Kelantan but is a favourite among Kelantanese. Its flat white rice noodles (kuey teow) are immersed in a white gravy made of minced mackerel fish fried with onions, garlic, ginger, black pepper, lemongrass, tamarind, kantan (torch-ginger) flower, shrimp paste and Vietnamese coriander. The coconut milk is added last, and the dish is topped with chopped long beans, cucumber, bean sprouts and blended chilies.



A little exercise is always good for you, but why should you consider running? Apart from the fact that you only need a pair of proper running shoes to get started, there are a host of benefits that running provides.



# **BENEFITS**



# SHARPENS YOUR FOCUS

Runners often report a runner's high when running. You get to switch off, go into a meditation-like state, which in turn can boost concentration, focus and fight depression and anxiety.



# FIGHTS HEART DISEASE

By becoming a runner, you significantly reduce your risk of cardiovascular disease. The Journal of the American College of Cardiology published a landmark study revealing that a slow-speed five to 10 minute run per day can lower your risk of dying from heart disease by up to 50%.



# TRANSFORMS YOUR BODY

As well as weight loss, running also helps define leg muscles, works your rectus abdominis (your six-pack muscles), your glutes and also your deeper core muscles, meaning you'll become a real head-turner!



# LIFTS YOUR

When you run, your brain releases two powerful mood-altering chemicals, namely endorphins and endocannabinoids, which actually make you feel good.



# STRENGTHENS YOUR BONES

Runners are half as likely to experience knee osteoarthritis compared with walkers, which may seem surprising, given that runners actively exert more stress on their joints during runs. However, a study in Medicine & Science in Sports & Exercise suggested that bones and cartilage only get stronger under the strain of running, just like your muscles.



### **BURNS CALORIES**

An average person who weighs 70kg can burn about 12.2 calories per minute when running a 10-minute mile, on flat terrain alone. You'll burn even more calories when you throw in some up-hill runs to your daily routine.



# **MARK WILLIAMS**

# What tips would you give to someone who is considering running for the first time?

The route to completing a marathon should be a journey. Only then can running become a lifelong habit. So, I would recommend that people make sure that they are physically able to start running by getting a full medical checkup. Secondly, get a good pair of running shoes. Shoes are the most important piece of equipment for a runner, so make sure that you get professional advice on which pair to purchase – and always buy a reputable brand!

# If you are a newbie runner, how do you stay motivated to keep on running?

Involve others! For example, join a running club or just involve yourself with people of a similar mindset, like those wanting to start running. This is so much easier to do these days with social media.

# Dedicated runners speak of the stress-relieving and meditative powers of the sport. True?

Yes, correct to a certain degree, but I have come across a minority of people who seem, for want of a better description, to be physiologically addicted to exercise.

# What is your happiest memory of running?

Breaking the Hong Kong Half Marathon national record in Incheon in South Korea in 2005. The culmination of many years of hard training felt as if it had really paid off at that moment!

What is your dream marathon? The Great Wall Marathon in China.

# **5 MINUTES WITH RYÖTJONES**

Meet RyötJones, a big band with a big sound. It all started with jamming sessions initiated by 'Deo (Karmawan, electric guitars) who met Kyren Thomas after a gig. Four months after forming their eight-member band, they entered the 'Rock the House' talent competition only to steal the grand prize at the finale eight weeks later. To say 2016 was the break-out year for RyötJones would be something of an understatement. So infectious was their blend of funk and soul that the band were soon lined up to play increasingly bigger gigs across the country, with record labels fighting for their signatures. Now, the funksters are set to release their debut single, Dancing Shoes. That said, we caught up with the group's energetic frontman, Kyren Thomas.

# Who or what inspires you?

When it comes to RyötJones, all our inspirations vary. We try to put a new spin on genres you don't see many young people in KL getting into. Internationally we look to the likes of James Brown, Earth Wind and Fire, BB King, Prince, Jamiroquai, Alabama Shakes, and Bruno Mars. Locally we're massively influenced by the likes of P. Ramlee, Salammusik, Tilu, QSound and Darren Ashley. I reckon we've just taken inspiration from people who've made music at its purest in terms of expression, people who have stayed true to what they do.

### In what positive ways has the Malaysian music scene changed?

The local music scene's biggest change came from it acting as a melting pot for all kinds of music. We see people from all genres and even different art forms coming

together and collaborating. Today, listening to local music has become cool again.

### What influenced your single **Dancing Shoes and what sort of** vibe does it have?

Dancing Shoes best describes the band's main goal of musical expression. We want people dancing at our shows, moving and singing along. It's just a darn good time accompanied by real danceable music that isn't generated by clicking buttons on a computer screen. It's one of our more pop-influenced songs, but still carries that big band heavy brass nature of RyötJones. It's an old school sound with a new school influence.

#### What excites you most about the music scene right now?

The collaborations between artists from all genres of music. Even artists from different forms of

media are collaborating to make amazing works which enhance local productions, be it from video/photographers to artists and writers. It's become one massive collaboration within the art scene.

# Who would be your dream collaboration?

As of now our wishlist of collaborations with musicians would definitely include QSound, Acap from Salammusik, Darren Ashley, Mira from Tilu, and Sonaone. We're even looking at young hiphop acts like Kid Santhe and Airliftz.


